POSSIBLE FUNDING

Please see below some information on grants available to sport cubs and sport people. The last 3, especially, are from foundations and aimed at young people. I am wondering, giving the difficulty some cadets have to transition to the adult knock down team and the lack of funds the cadets have to travel and compete (due to BKK having limited funds for adults and the cadet being still in school or not earning enough to be able to support their training) – if those three funds especially could be tapped into to help some of our youngsters. Community sporting facilities

Sport England's Inspired Facilities fund will provide capital grants to refurbish and improve community sporting facilities. Community and voluntary organisations and parish and town councils will be able to apply for £20,000 - £50,000. The first deadline for applications is 28 September 2011.

Participation in sport

The Dickie Bird Foundation provides support for individuals with the aim of helping disadvantaged young people (under 18) to participate in sport, to the best of their ability, in the sport of their choice, irrespective of their social circumstances, culture or ethnicity. Eligible costs are sports kit, coaching and training. Grants given are normally between £100 and £5,000, although more may be given in certain circumstances.
