BKK Affiliation Form for the year 2009/2010

I am enclosing a renewal form for affiliation to the BKK. I would be grateful if this could be completed and returned to me together with cheque payable to the BKK for **£55.00** by **NO LATER than 30th November 2009.**

You will note that there is no increase in the fee this year – we have maintained a capped sum this year against yearly increases by our insurers and I would point out that the charge made to dojos is still being subsidised by the BKK in an attempt to assist dojos financially.

I cannot emphasise enough the importance in returning your form by the above date. If you fail to do this it WILL effect the running of your dojo and may leave you open to serious problems should there be an accident etc. within your dojo during training. Such is the seriousness of the matter – if you have not re affiliated by the 30th November it WILL affect your club regarding Club Gradings, National Gradings, Tournaments and other functions within the BKK.

I am sure you will understand the position and the necessity to give you and your student's full insurance cover - and not leave yourself open to criticism and possible litigation should something go wrong whilst uninsured.
