Please see below some information on grants available to sport cubs and sport people. The last 3, especially, are from foundations and aimed at young people. I am wondering, given the difficulty some cadets have to transition to the adult knock down team and the lack of funds the cadets have to travel and compete (due to BKK having limited funds for adults and the cadet being still in school or not earning enough to be able to support their training) – if those three funds especially could be tapped into to help some of our youngsters. Eligible costs are sports kit, coaching and training. Grants given are normally between £100 and £5,000, although more may be given in certain circumstances.

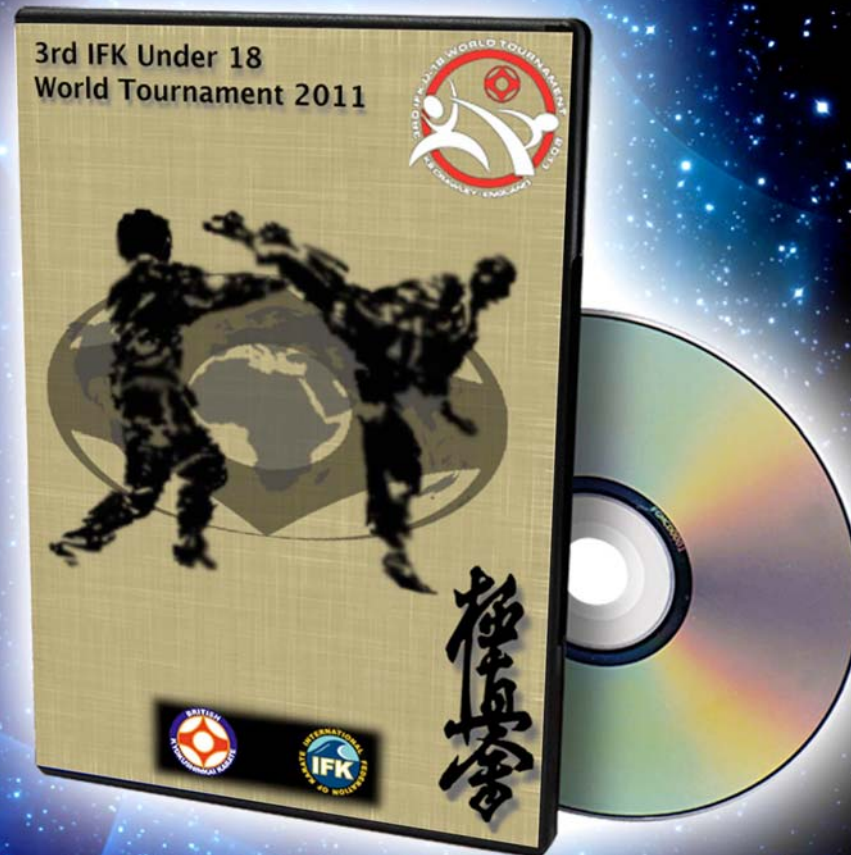
