It has been confirmed that the Junior & Cadet World Tournament is coming to England next year!!

As the Great Britain Coach I would like to ask all Juniors, Cadets, Instructors and members to start preparing for this prestigious event.

Over the next year myself and the Welsh Coach, Sensei John Moulden will be holding squad sessions in England and Wales. We will also hold GB squad sessions on a regular basis around the country. A list of GB Squad sessions will be coming out shortly.

Any Junior or Cadet who wishes to be considered to be part of the GB Squad **MUST** attend as many England, Wales and Great Britain Squad sessions as possible. I would also like written confirmation of your attendance at your dojo over the past six months from your Instructor. Commitment and dedication is the name, not just at squad sessions but at your own Dojo. It is also important for you to attend Hanshi's course on the 9th May at Shenley Leisure Centre, Milton Keynes and the Junior Summer Camp, Cadets at the Senior Camp 18th - 22nd August. You can download the forms from the BKK website.

Instructors: If you have students who are good fighters and eligible for the World Tournament next year please, please encourage them to come to Squads. It is a great opportunity for all Juniors and Cadets. If they have not been to a Squad before it is not a problem as long as they start coming now!! World Tournament age is Juniors 12 - 15 years old, Cadets 16 - 17 years old. You must be in these age brackets on the day of the tournament!

I will be selecting the GB Teams at the end of this year/early 2011 so that the fighters have plenty of time to prepare for the Tournament. A preliminary Squad of 50 (Junior & Cadet) fighters will be selected in October and from that 50 I will then pick the Junior and Cadet GB teams.
